There have been some exciting changes made to our service space and we have been working on incorporating more of the children's voices in our displays.

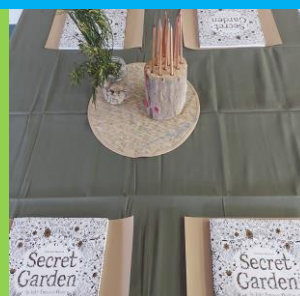

We would love for all our families to share a family photo with us, so that we can watch our tree blossom and allow children to feel a sense of belonging within our TheirCare family.

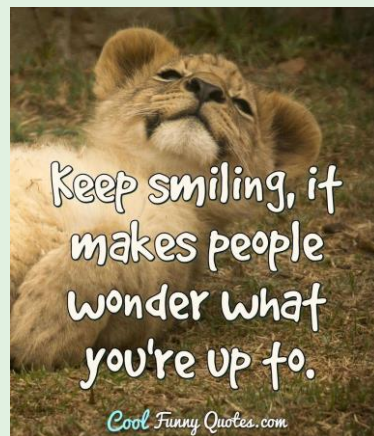
